



PART TIME TRAINEESHIPS - LIFEGUARDS -

The Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre is seeking to recruit enthusiastic and diligent team players to join the Aquatic team on a 12 month traineeship as a lifeguard. The position requires excellent service delivery skills, a strong work ethic and a commitment to learn.

The successful applicants will be responsible for providing a customer focused service that ensures the safety and supervision of patrons within the aquatic area. This includes event operations, water quality, and the maintenance and cleanliness of the aquatic area.

Successful applicants will complete a Certificate III or IV in Community Recreation delivered by the MSAC Institute of Training (MIT). To be eligible for a traineeship you must commit to a minimum of 13 hours per week for 12 months and must not have any prior qualifications higher than Certificate 2 level (i.e. Certificate III, IV, Diploma, Degree). Trainees will also commit to training sessions facilitated by MIT and the completion of all assessment components required.

This is a fantastic opportunity to gain practical experience and a formal qualification.

Level 2 First Aid

(Both of which may be obtained, if you are successful in securing a traineeship)
